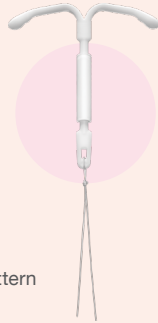

Long Acting

Methods need to be placed every 3 to 10 years, except Sterilization which is permanent.

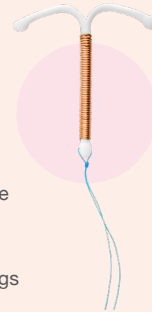
IUS – Hormonal Intrauterine System

- ★ Super effective
- Long-acting reversible
- Easy to hide
- May cause changes in menstrual bleeding pattern
- Up to 3-6 years



IUD – Copper Intrauterine Device

- ★ Super effective
- Long-acting reversible
- Easy to hide
- May cause heavier bleedings or crampings
- Up to 5–10 years



The Implant Hormonal Method

- ★ Super effective
- Long-acting reversible
- Easy to hide
- It may initially cause a change in bleeding patterns
- Up to 3–5 years



Sterilization Permanent Method

- ★ Super effective
- Hormone free
- Non-reversible
- Permanent



Regular Routine

Methods need to be remembered between once a day and once every 3 months.

The Pill Hormonal Method

- ★ Highly effective
- Widely available
- Easy to use
- Need to think about it daily
- Every day



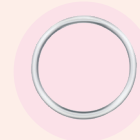
The Patch Hormonal Method

- ★ Highly effective
- Widely available
- Easy to use
- It's visible and may come loose or fall off
- Every week



Vaginal Ring Hormonal Method

- ★ Highly effective
- Widely available
- Easy to use
- Can cause vaginal discomfort or irritation
- Every month



Injection Hormonal Method

- ★ Highly effective
- Widely available
- Easy to use
- It may initially cause a change in bleeding patterns
- 1, 2 or 3 months



Single Use

Methods need to be used every single time you have sex.

Fertility Awareness Timing Method

- ★ Less effective
- Low or no costs
- Hormone free
- Very low reliability
- Every day



Barrier Methods Barrier Method

- ★ Less effective
- Low costs
- Hormone free
- Interrupts sex
- Every time



Condoms Barrier Method

- ★ Less effective
- STI protection
- Hormone free
- Interrupts sex
- Single use



The only method that protects from STIs including HIV
